2008 Team Camp

Camp Philosophy

The 2008 Team Camp will be held at the Fort Hays State University Football facilities and directed by head coach, Kevin Verdugo, and the FHSU football staff. Team camp will feature an emphasis on techniques and the fundamentals of football. The camp will provide an opportunity for individual time and instruction, competition, and team work. The goal of football camp is to ensure that each student athlete will leave camp a better football player than when he arrived.

Team Camp June 1-3

Open to teams with players entering grades 9-12. Individual student athletes whose high school team is not coming to camp are encouraged to attend camp. The student athlete will be placed on a "Renegade Tiger" team or team needing to fill certain positions. Practice sessions will have individual periods to work football specific drills to improve techniques for offensive and defensive positions. There will be controlled group periods to accentuate the skills learned in individual periods. Helmet, shoulder pads, jersey and mouthpieces will be required.

Arrive: June 1 at Wiest Hall lobby, 9 a.m.-12 p.m.

Depart: June 3 at Wiest Hall lobby, 3-4 p.m.

Overnight campers will be housed in FHSU air conditioned dormitories. **Campers must provide their own bedding and personal care items.** Coaching staff will be staying in dorms



with the campers each night. Overnight campers will receive generous, well balanced meals in our campus dining facility. The cost for commuter campers covers only the practice sessions. Commuters will have to provide their own meals and snacks. Violation of camp rules may result in dismissal from camp with all tuition forfeited.

Costs:

- Overnight camper needing to rent equipment \$185
- Overnight camper \$170
- Commuter needing to rent equipment \$125
- Commuter \$110

***A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required with this application. Balance of tuition is due upon registration.**

***Each camper must provide a signed copy of his 2007-2008 physical form, completed registration form, parental authorization/medical information form, and signed emergency medical authorization to participate.**

***Campers must have health insurance or they will not be allowed to participate in camp.**

Head Coach Kevin Verdugo



Kevin Verdugo enters his fourth season as head coach at Fort Hays State University in 2008. He guides the Tigers into their third season as members of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, one of the elite conferences in NCAA Division II.

Verdugo came to the Tiger program from the University of Akron, where he served as an assistant coach for the Zips. Prior to Akron, he was the head coach at Fort Scott Community College for three seasons. Verdugo was tabbed the 2001 Kansas Jayhawk Conference Coach of the Year while at FSCC. He led Fort Scott to a 5-4 record that season, including a victory over top-ranked Garden City Community College.

Under Verdugo's offense, quarterback Bill Whittemore was named Jayhawk Conference Player of the Year in 2001 and went on to sign with Kansas where he was the Big XII Offensive Newcomer of the Year in 2002.

Verdugo was the quarterbacks coach at Southern Illinois for the 2000 season and spent two seasons (1997-98) as offensive coordinator/running backs coach at Northern Michigan.

From 1994-96, Verdugo served as the quarterbacks (1994-96) and wide receiver coach (1996) at Southeast Missouri State. In 1994, he coached Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Year Fred Hosten, and as recruiting coordinator, he covered the states of Florida, California, Kansas, Missouri and Oklahoma.

A former college quarterback, Verdugo began his career at Kansas (1987) before finishing up at Colorado State (1988-91). He spent two training camps (1992-93) with the New Orleans Saints and the 1994 preseason camp with the Shreveport Pirates of the CFL.
